

# **ASK Jesus His Way to Pray**

Martin Lifer/ May 12, 2024/ Luke 11:1-2a In the gospels, what is the ONLY action a disciple asked Jesus to teach them?

Lk. 11:1b one of His disciples..., "Lord, teach US to pray!" Key 1st Step?

## 1) Affirm Jesus as Lord, Attuning Ourselves to Him, Our Advocate "Lord!"

Heb. 12:2 Fix our eyes on Jesus, the Author and Perfecter of faith, Who for the joy set before Him endured the cross, ... and [ASCENDED] has sat down at the right hand of God's throne.

Jesus consistently prayed intensely. [Lk. 3:21, 5:16, 6:12, 9:18 & 9:28-29; Mk. 1:35 & 9:29]

Lk. 9:51 as ...days... fulfilled for his Ascension analempseos, He fixed his face to go to Jerusalem.

## 2) Admit We Are Children, Totally Needing Him (& His Teaching)

Lk. 18:17 "whoever does not receive God's Kingdom like a child shall not enter it." "Lord, Teach us!"

## 3) Attach (a) to Him (b) to One Another as His Church

Jn. 15:5a "I am the Vine, you [plural] are the branches." (also Eph. 4:15-16)

Attach to Him

## 4) Ask Jesus to Teach US His Way to Pray **ASK Jesus!**

## His Wav

## 5) Abolish Anxiety by PRAYING with Thanks Always in Christ
