
Poinsettias for Palmer Home

Demon Democracy or God's Kingdom?

The Bible holds up which government type? NOT a democracy but a

Jesus teaches us to pray NOT for the coming of our democracy but God's _

In the Bible, *majority vote* almost always leads to

In Lk. 8:26-39, two unanimous "democratic" votes: 1) All demons in the "Legion" ask to enter the herd of pigs; 2) All in the region's multitude fearfully ask Jesus to leave them.

I can have my "vote" in a demon democracy, or be saved by the King & be his subject.

Lk. 8:22-56 In New Series of Miracles, Jesus Calls His Church to Bold MISSIONARY Faith in HIM as LORD with Authority over Danger, Demons, Disease & Death.

"Let us go across over to the other side." Lk. 8:22b 1st Storm (8:23-25); 2nd The Decapolis 8:26-39

Jesus takes disciples on Foreign Mission to Decapolis/ SEC (Region of Gerasenes or Gergasenes)

Greeting Party: Demoniac! 8:27/Jesus' Mission: "proclaim liberty to the captives." Lk. 4:18

- A) "Who then is this?" 8:25 "Jesus, Son of the Most High God." 8:28
- B) "What is your name?" 8:30 "Legion!" Am I one of the demon democracy crowd, or...?

Demon Democracy 1.0 The Mighty Majority = fearful beggars before

"I bea You!" Begged Him not to order them into the abyss. Begged to let them enter these.

Deliverance of the Demoniac! Salvation through Judgment

→ the one saved [esōthē 8:36] sitting at Jesus' feet, clothed and in his right mind 8:35

Demon Democracy 2.0 All the multitude of the region asked Him to leave: No Jesus!

Gospel Ironies: 1) Those who oppose & reject Jesus will be granted their vote/beg: democratic death;...

- 2) Those saved & belonging to the King don't always get their "begs" but are sent by Him into his mission -
- 3) Even gospel grace to rebels in the democracy of death for the King's glory.
