Christian on Purpose with Power

Martin Lifer/ FPC Starkville/ December 10. 2023/ Luke 9:1-6

Jesus did not call and form a church of committees or train his disciples to be chair-sitters, club-creators, or complainers (i.e. Pharisees)

He calls people to follow Him into Kingdom Mission on \_\_\_\_\_ with \_\_\_\_

Lk. 8:1-9:50 - 2d Cycle of Jesus' Public Ministry before 'He set his face to go to Jerusalem." (9:51)

Jesus prepares his disciples to be &to lead His **Church-in-Mission**.

"One cannot **embody** authentic **discipleship** [without knowing in faith] the **nature** of **Jesus' Person** & **Work**; yet one **cannot** ... **comprehend** [His] **Person** & **Work** apart from... **discipleship**."

Am I a Christian on Purpose ... with Power? Fruit? Stewardship Faith? Witness?

Christians' Purpose & Christians' Power

Jesus began proclaiming the Kingdom in Word & Action w/ Authority & Power, incl. over demons & disease. Lk. 4 Now He calls & gives The 12 Authority & Power and same mission. 9:1-6

9:1-2 - The 12 represent New Israel/Church-in-Mission [named as a group or indiv. Name given 12 x in 9:1-49]

True Christians worship, give & serve on purpose with power, not mere talk. 1 cor. 4:20.

**Christians' Provision:** Living by Faith Alone in Christ Alone 9:3-4 – "Take nothing (!) for your journey:..."

**Christians'** Prophetic Role *vis-à-vis* those who don't receive and/or don't give 9:5 - "... shake off the dust from your feet as a testimony against them."

**Christians' Participate** in His mission to save others... and in His Eternal Inheritance 9:6 – "They **departed & went**... **preaching the gospel** and **healing** everywhere."
