

Jesus on Judgment: Measure in Grace

Contrary to common misreading and misuse of Lk. 6:37 & Mt. 7:1, Jesus does NOT forbid all moral judgments. He actually calls us to make many moral judgments and to discern wisely according to His Word BUT commands us NOT to be judgmental and condemning in the hard-hearted, critical spirit of self-righteous hypocrites.

Lk. 6:37 μὴ κρίνετε (2P Pl) – Krino (& kritikos): roots of Engl. words "criticize" & "critical"

Mediate Mercy
Mature in Meekness with the Master

Measure Generously
Mind the Mirror Before Ministering

1. Mediate Mercy: Be a Mediator of Mercy, NOT an Executioner of Your Own Judgment.

Be patient in living with the faults of others; they have to be patient living with yours!

2. Measure Generously: Give & Forgive, Trusting God's Ultimate Grace to You.

3. Mature in Meekness with the Master: Follow Jesus, Not Yourself or Other Blind Guides.
