- 1) Commit, 2) Comprehend, and 3) Construct your house in His House.
- 1) COMMIT to His Household: Christ's New Covenant Communion & Community He lifted up his eyes on his disciples... "Blessed are you who are the poor, because yours [pl.] is the Kingdom of God.... when people hate you, exclude you [pl.],... on account of the Son of Man." Lk. 6:20,22

Beatitudes & Woes: Jesus calls us to be poor to the World, treasuring Him & His House.

2) COMPREHEND the Expectations & Promises of the New Covenant.
