






How did Christ humble himself in his death?



Judas Iscariot (Disciple, Apostle, Leader... & Traitor)

In my own life – surprising turns of people & events:

(1) Prayer = Faithful Choice: *Declaration of Dependence* on God's Plan & Grace. He spent the night in prayer with God. Lk. 6:12b
